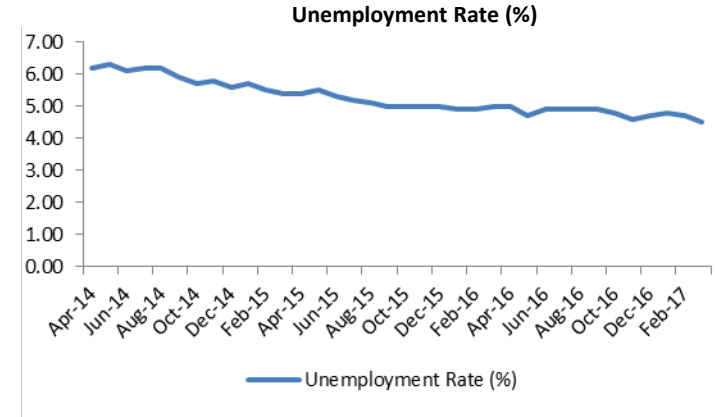
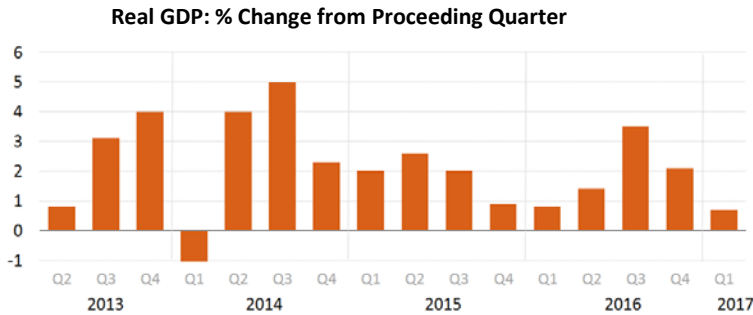

## Industry Headlines

- **March 16<sup>th</sup>** – Engineering and Construction executives see gains from Trump administration agenda. (*ENR 1Q Cost Report Confidence Survey*)
- **March 31<sup>st</sup>** – TRC Companies, Inc. (NYSE: TRR) today announced that it has entered into a definitive merger agreement with New Mountain Partners, a leading private equity fund, for approximately \$658 million (14.6x EBITDA) representing a 46% stock premium from the prior day close.
- **February 27<sup>th</sup>** – Rental revenue forecast strengthens, penetration rate stays steady. U.S. equipment rental revenue will reach \$48.9 billion in 2017, but then grow at an average annual rate of 4.6% over the forecast to top \$56 billion in 2020. (*American Rental Association's (ARA)*)
- **January 25<sup>th</sup>** – United Rentals, Inc. (NYSE: URI) and NES Rentals Holdings II, Inc. ("NES") today announced that they have entered into a definitive agreement under which United Rentals will acquire NES for approximately \$965 million in cash.
- **January 9<sup>th</sup>** – Wearable technology has arrived. Its popularity is evident in the growing demand for products, such as smart watches and FitBits. This technology is also impacting the HVAC industry as more and more contractors discover how smart glasses can aid their businesses, particularly in the commercial sector. (*The News*)

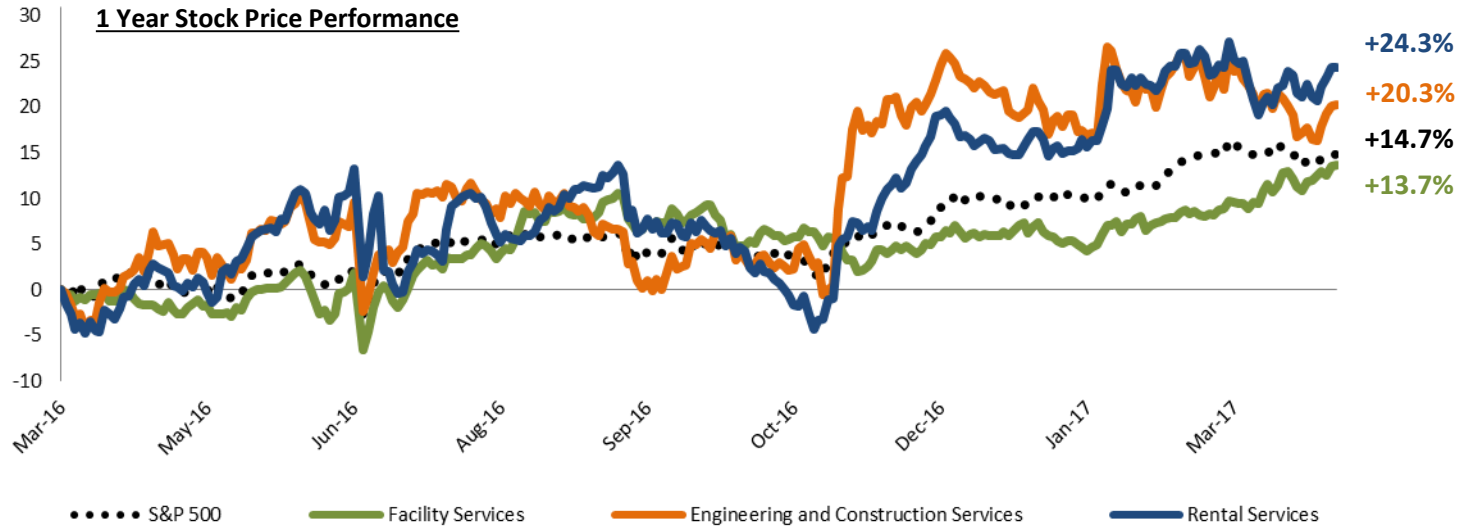

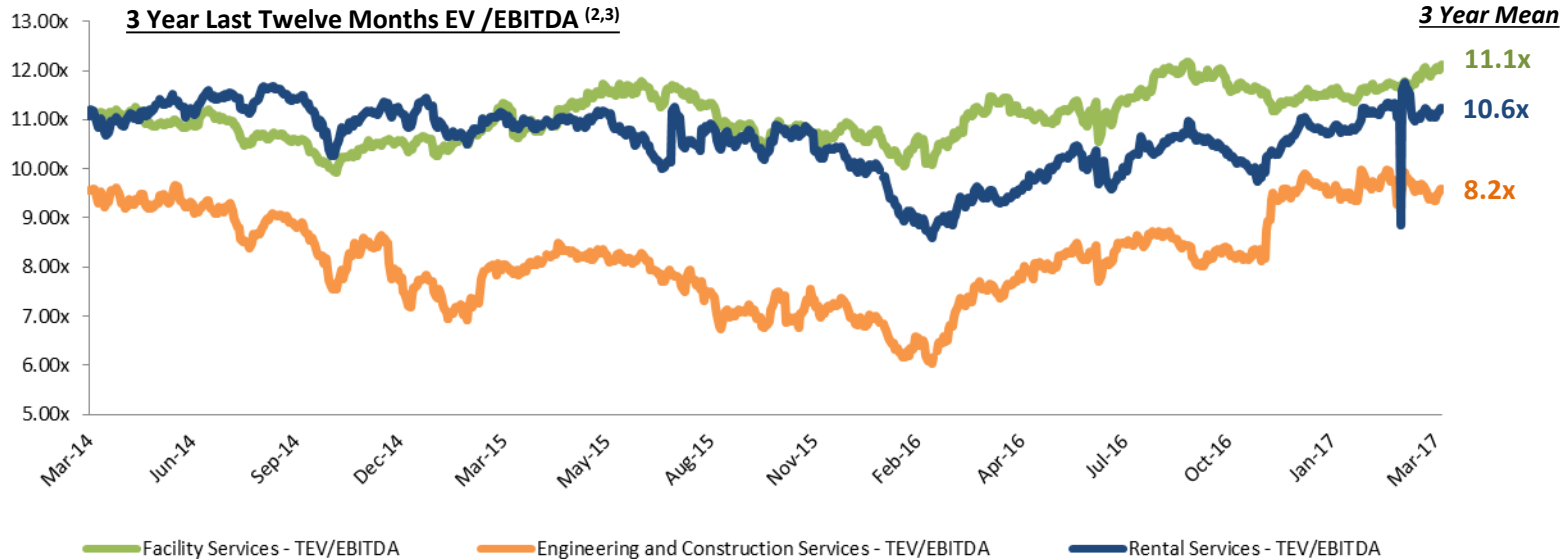
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# Public Market Activity

## Industrial Services M&A Activity

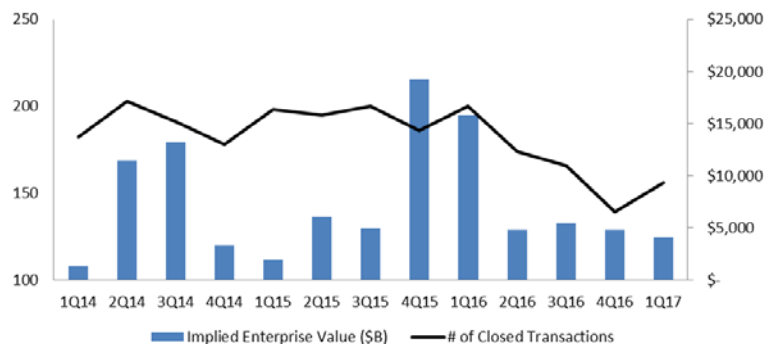
- A total of **156** transactions were closed in 1Q17 (22% decline compared to 1Q16) with an aggregate enterprise value of ~**\$4.1 billion** (74% decline compared to 1Q16)
- United Rentals** (NYSE: URI) acquired **NES Rentals**, one of the ten largest general equipment rental companies in the U.S., for ~\$1 billion (6.2x EBITDA) in January 2017
- New Mountain Capital** acquired **TRC Companies** (NYSE: TRR), an engineering, environmental consulting and construction management company, for ~\$0.7 billion in March 2017
- Fueled by a low interest-rate environment, Debt/EBITDA multiples approached **4.0x** in 2016 compared to **3.5x** in 2012

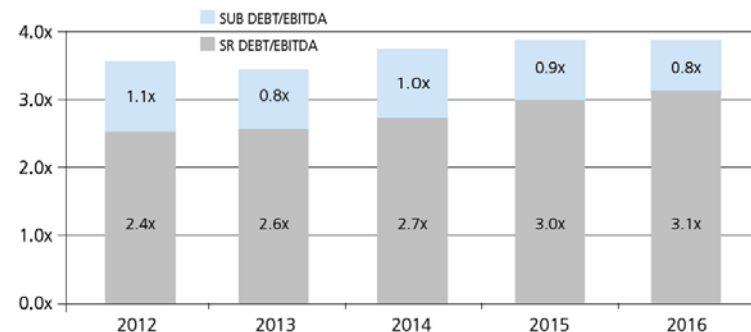
